



# Yr 9 – Fact Sheet

## COVID-19 Safe Return Plan to onsite learning

### Week 4 B, Monday 25<sup>th</sup> October

Yr 9 students return to school under Level 3 + setting:

- Vaccinated Staff onsite
- Masks are mandatory indoors
- No mingling with other student cohorts (Year groups)

#### Year 9 COVID-19 Safety Plan

- School Bell:** 8.25am. Gates will be open at 8 am.
- Entry and Exit points to SCHS:** Year 9 students enter and leave school through Botany Ave Carpark Gates located near the Industrial Arts building ONLY.
- Arrival at school:** Year 9 students are to remain on the Top Terrace.

**N.B In the event of wet weather on Monday morning, Year 9 will proceed directly to the E block lower area.**

- Designated playground area:** Top Terrace
- Learning Space:** Your classes will now all be held in classrooms in E Block.  
You will be issued a new timetable with your new rooms.  
Your teachers will come to your classroom.  
You need to bring all your own equipment – no sharing.

Students are to enter E Block via the Basketball end stairway and exit via the HUB end stairway in a staggered approach.

Year 9 will follow their normal timetable for lessons in their allocated classroom.

- Recess & Lunch:**

Yr 9 will exit their classroom, via the HUB end stairway in a staggered approach.

The canteen will be operating on a limited menu based on a pre ordering system. Students will not be permitted to line up at the canteen. We are currently working on a suitable process with our canteen provider. This will be communicated to parents asap.

It is strongly recommended that students bring their own food and water bottle/drinks for the school day.

- Toilets:**

Class time – HSIE / Disabled toilets in E Block (no mingling)

Breaks - HSIE / Disabled toilets in E Block (no mingling)

- At the end of the day Year 9 students will leave school through Botany Ave Carpark Gates located near the Industrial Arts building ONLY.
