COVID-19 Safe Return Plan to onsite learning

Week 4 B, Monday 25th October

Yr 10 students return to school under Level 3 + setting:

- Vaccinated Staff onsite
- Masks/Face coverings are mandatory indoors
- No mingling, minimised interactions and contact with other student cohorts (Year groups)

Year 10 COVID-19 Safety Plan

- School Bell:** 8.25am
- Entry and Exit points to SCHS:** Year 10 students enter and leave school through the Pedestrian Gate located on Botany Ave ONLY. Gates will be opened at 8.00am.
- Arrival at school:** Year 10 students are to make their way using walkway between office and Science blocks and remain in the Lower Quad, they are not permitted to enter other areas of the school to mingle or interact with students from other year groups.

N.B In the event of wet weather on Monday morning, Year 10 will proceed directly to the Hall via the walkway outside Home Ec/Music rooms. Yr 10 Students are then to remain in the Hall.

- Designated playground area:** Lower Quad.
- Learning Space:** Your classes will now all be held in the Science Rooms.
You will be issued a new timetable with your new rooms.
Your teachers will come to your classroom.
You need to bring all your own equipment – no sharing.

Students are to enter the Science block via Office/Science walkway opposite Botany Avenue.

Year 10 will follow their normal timetable for lessons in their allocated classroom where most classes will be conducted.

- Recess & Lunch:**

Yr 10 will forward out of their classroom, proceed to the Lower Quad, in a staggered approach.

The canteen will be operating on a limited menu based on a pre ordering system. Students will not be permitted to line up at the canteen. We are currently working on a suitable process with our canteen provider. This will be communicated to parents asap.

It is strongly recommended that students bring their own food and water bottle/drinks for the school day.

- Toilets:**

Class time – Office Toilets

Breaks – Canteen Toilets

At the end of the day Year 10 students will leave through Office/Science exit and make their way to pedestrian gate at crossing on Botany Avenue.
