







# BYOD Specifications

The device should be light weight, have a protective cover/ case and must meet **all** the following requirements:

Hardware Specifications:	
<b>Wireless Connectivity</b>	<p><b><i>**This is the most important specification as there will be no internet access if your device does not comply**</i></b></p> <p>Device <u>must have</u> 5GHz</p> <p>Note: This may be advertised as 'Dual Band Wireless, 802.11abgn, 802.11agn, 802.11ac or gigabit wireless.</p> 
<b>Device</b>	<p>Laptop ONLY, with a screen size of at least 11 inches (13" recommended)</p> <p><u><i>A mobile phone or tablet is not an acceptable device including any device with a SIM card.</i></u></p> 
<b>Storage Space</b>	<p>Minimum 128Gb (SSD) or higher storage on a Windows device. (256Gb recommended)</p> 
<b>Memory</b>	<p>At least 4GB (8GB preferred) of RAM.</p> 
<b>Operating System</b>	<p>Microsoft Windows 10 or 11.</p> 
<b>Battery Life</b>	<p>Advertised battery life of at least six hours</p> 

Peripheral Connections	
<b>USB port</b>	At least 1 USB port to connect external storage, printers and other plug and play devices
<b>Headphone jack</b>	Some lessons, NAPLAN and other exams will require the use of audio and you will need headphones to ensure that you can hear clearly. Bluetooth headphones are not suitable.
<b>External Display</b>	HDMI or VGA port
