The device should be light weight, have a protective cover/ case and must meet **all** the following requirements:

Wireless Connectivity	<p>**This is the most important specification as there will be no internet access if your device does not comply**</p> <p>Device <u>must have</u> 5GHz</p> <p>Note: This may be advertised as 'Dual Band Wireless, 802.11abgn, 802.11agn, 802.11ac or gigabit wireless.</p> 
Device	<p>Laptop ONLY, with a screen size of at least 11 inches</p> <p><u>A mobile phone is not an acceptable device OR any device with a SIM card.</u></p> 
Storage Space	<p>Minimum 128Gb (SSD) or 500GB (HDD) storage on a Windows device</p> 
Memory	<p>At least 4GB (8GB preferred) of RAM.</p> 
Operating System	<p>Microsoft Windows 10</p> 
Battery Life	<p>Advertised battery life of at least six hours</p> 

Peripheral Connections	
USB port	At least 1 USB port to connect external storage, printers and other plug and play devices
Headphone jack	Some lessons will require the use of audio and you will need headphones to ensure that you can hear clearly.
External Display	HDMI or VGA port
