EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIPS and SCHOOL GRANT AWARDS

Applications for the 2012 *NSW Premier's Student Volunteering Awards* Education Scholarships and School Grant awards are now open.

Ten education scholarships of \$2,000 each, as well as one school grant of \$5,000, will be awarded.

Students who have demonstrated that they are outstanding volunteers in their community through the *NSW Premier's Student Volunteering Awards* program can be nominated, or can nominate themselves for the Education Scholarship Award.

Schools that have shown a commitment to supporting the engagement of their students in volunteering through participation in the *NSW Premier's Student Volunteering Awards* program are eligible to apply for the *NSW Premier's Student Volunteering Awards* School Grant.
