St Clair High School - uniform requirements

Dear Parents and Carers

At St Clair High School we are grateful that the majority of our students wear their uniform as expected and do this in a way that demonstrates respect for the School and pride in their personal appearance.

Our school uniform policy was reviewed and updated in 2016 and the decision was made to not allow students to wear representative jumpers as part of our school uniform. Representative sports jumpers do not align with our newly implemented uniform policy which includes the consideration of the WHS policy of student identification.

While the School uniform serves the purpose of setting our students apart from other schools, the wearing of a uniform prepares students in a number of ways for life beyond their School experience. Uniforms are worn in most places of employment in some form, ranging from food and retail outlets to the building and trade industry

The task of wearing a school uniform as required helps prepare our students for this eventuality and indicates a willingness to follow instructions, show pride in one's appearance and acknowledge their acceptance of the school community expectations.

While we are proud to indicate that most of our students wear their uniform correctly every day, we are aware of a small number of students who continue to struggle to meet uniform expectations. In order to assist them in lifting their standard of uniform we are reminding our school community of our **uniform procedures:**

To assist students to meet our uniform expectations, staff will be monitoring student uniforms from the start of Week 6 this term, 4th June, using the following approach. Parent and carer support is greatly appreciated.

1. Any student who arrives to school out of uniform and does not have a uniform pass (green slip) will have their name recorded by their classroom teacher on our school recording system, SENTRAL as a uniform breach.
2. Any student, who arrives at school and is not identified with any part of our school uniform i.e. is completely out of school uniform, wearing incorrect colour, will be sent directly to the Deputy Principal for disciplinary action. This may involve being sent home.
3. Assistant Year Advisers will generate a report and identify students who have three uniform breaches and refer the student to the Year Group Head Teacher for disciplinary action that includes a lunch detention and a phone call home.
4. Three lunch detentions result in an afterschool detention and referral to the Deputy Principal for continued disobedience.

Special considerations

Any student is unable to wear the correct school uniform on any given day must bring a note from home, indicating why, to obtain a uniform pass (green slip) from the Head Teacher Wellbeing, Year Adviser, Assistant Year Adviser or their Deputy before the start of school.

Any student who is genuinely unable to comply with the school uniform requirements due to financial reasons is expected to make contact with the school Principal, Deputy Principals or Head Teacher Wellbeing at their earliest convenience. Arrangements will be made at the school to assist the student to comply with the school's dress code.

- Junior polo shirt – white with school logo
- Junior maroon skirt or junior maroon shorts with school logo
- Junior fitted maroon pants
- Junior maroon fleecy jumper

- Predominantly black or white enclosed shoes.



Junior Boys: Years 7-10

- Junior polo shirt – white with school logo
- Junior maroon shorts with school logo

- Predominantly black or white enclosed shoes.

SPORT/ P.E. CLASSES

- Sports Polo Shirt
- Sports Shorts standard length OR Sports Shorts long length with school logo.
- Microfibre jacket and pants.

- Shoes: Predominantly black OR predominantly white
- Cap/hat is recommended.



SENIOR BOYS

- Senior Polo Shirt – sky blue
- Grey Shorts OR Grey Trousers
- Senior Fleecy Jumper Top – Grey
- Shoes: Predominantly black OR predominantly white
- Cap/hat is recommended.
